Ways to give

Standing Order

This is an instruction from you to your bank to pay Wells Cathedral a set amount of your choice every month, quarter or year. This is an easy way to give to the Cathedral and a standing order form is included overleaf. If you donate by standing order please feel free to just pass on the collection basket at services.

Weekly Blue Envelopes

If you regularly attend services at the Cathedral and would prefer to donate by cash or cheque we can issue you with a set of blue weekly envelopes to use. Each envelope is marked with the date to help you keep track of your contributions. If you are unable to attend and wish to catch up at any time you can put more than one week's envelope into the collection. If you wish to register for planned giving and receive blue envelopes please complete and return the form included in this leaflet.

Gift Aid

Whichever method of giving you choose, we ask UK tax payers to complete and return the attached Gift Aid declaration. This enables the Cathedral to reclaim the tax on each of your donations which costs you nothing. Gift Aid means we receive an additional 25p for every £1 you donate. You only need to complete this form once and we do everything else. Gift Aid significantly boosts income for Wells Cathedral.
